Our product.

IDS are a global provider of fleet risk management solutions and are experts in this area. It delivers research-driven products and services that have been independently validated by the Napier University in Edinburgh.

Our product offers you the flexibility to pick and choose the elements you require from electronic licence checking up to the full package.

Duty of Care – the benefits.

Our product allows your company to demonstrate an auditable record of managing risk showing diligence and control at all times, while managing your duty of care requirements and complying with international best practice on road safety. It gives you an at-a-glance view of who your high risk drivers are so you can focus any additional solutions towards them first. This also helps you to keep costs down by working with high risk drivers first, instead of using a blanket approach and training all drivers.

Typically, you can look to reduce your 'at fault' incidents and collisions by 30-40% over 3 years, which over time could lead to a reduction in insurance costs.

Our product can include:

The range comprises of the following elements which are delivered online:

Cultural Development Tools

- Safe Driving Pledge – customised pledge in which an employee agrees to obey the rules of the road and to adhere to all company rules, management standards, policies and driver's handbooks in the performance of his or her duties
- Risk Foundation Policy Assessment – an online questionnaire based on your company driver handbook which demonstrates information has been shared and understood

Risk Assessment Tools

- RoadRISK: Profile – an online fact based risk assessment which includes the following:
 - Driver – individual background, history, experience driving style, plus any incidents or endorsements
 - Journey – how far they drive, for how long and where
 - Vehicle – age, mileage, servicing and safety checks as well as how to use safety features correctly such as ABS

Duty of Care.

- RoadRISK Defensive Driving – an online competency based risk assessment which addresses the following driver conduct:
 - Attitude – what is their opinion on everyday driving situation and the potential issues with other road users
 - Knowledge – baseline knowledge of the Highway Code and defensive driving awareness
 - Behaviour – what would they do in routine everyday driving situations
 - Hazard – what should they be thinking about potentially hazardous situations, incident scenes, road-works, fatigue, driving at night etc
- Fleet Audit – holistic corporate risk assessment against Fleet Risk Management Best Practice
- Electronic licence Check – a DVLA check that will help you to see any driver endorsements and highlight and high risk drivers. Results are colour coded according to the endorsement history and classified as low, medium or high risk

Performance Management Tools

- DriverINDEX - customisable risk categories that, ranks drivers based on inputs including (but not limited to): DVLA Licence data, accident/ collision data, RoadRISK and individual Customer inputs and feeds, including the specific training for each risk category

Risk Reduction Tools

- One More Second - driver training programme covering defensive driving, importance of attitude and behaviour, a planned system of driving, hazard recognition, 20 tips to save your life, and a knowledge check
- RoadSKILLS - driver training programme covering motorway, city, country and general driving skills
- RiskCOACH - targeted training, intervention modules and assessment focused on fatigue, road rage, attitude, behaviour, hazard recognition, observation, blind spots, ABS and other topics as they are developed
- OneToOne - training for managers on assessing and coaching their drivers
- Management Reporting & Information System - including assessment tools-for recording and analysing the product; management tools-GAP analysis, best practice database
- Consultancy Assistance - IDS will provide at no extra charge consultancy on the design and set-up of the Safe Driving Pledge, Risk Foundation program and your driver safety policy.
